

Landmark Programs

The Erin Levitas Initiative for Sexual Assault Prevention at the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law

EDUCATE. Through our partnership with the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law, the Erin Levitas Foundation has worked with program director Dr. C. Quince Hopkins and five clinical law students to **design a first-of-its-kind curriculum to teach sexual assault prevention to middle school students.** The program focuses on Restorative Justice—a system of healing through reconciliation between victims and offenders—and has already undergone a 17-student pre-pilot with a Baltimore City School. The program will be administered to 60 students starting fall 2019 while undergoing assessment of program effectiveness by a public health consultant, with hopes that **the Erin Levitas Foundation can bring sexual assault prevention education to schools nationwide.**

The Erin Michele Levitas '11 Mind, Body and Soul Empowerment Program at St. Timothy's School

LISTEN. In partnership with St. Timothy's School, the Erin Levitas Foundation is focusing on mental health and wellness with a range of programs designed to promote open conversation and opportunities for self-care. Programs include: Wellness Wednesdays, making available 1-on-1 counseling to all students, a Wellness

Fair, a "Winterum" Week of health and wellness for sophomores, panels dedicated to sexual health

facilitated by health professionals and alumni, and college transition programming for seniors. The Mind, Body, and Soul Empowerment Program also includes classes for seniors about engaging in civil discourse related to safety and courageous conversations, a thorough sexual assault prevention education program based in power-based violence intervention and bystander intervention, self-care field trips, and a focus on developing and maintaining healthy relationships and friendships. The work of the Erin Levitas Foundation has

interacted a measured 430+ times with high school students through this initiative.

What's Next: Goals for the Erin Levitas Foundation

We know our programs have a deep impact on children, but we want to prove it. We are measuring the success of our programs and determining their impact on things like attendance, emotional intelligence, and classroom behavior.



pilot & test

In the pilot programs already conducted, we've heard amazing responses from students and our partners. Our next step is to pilot the program in additional schools with students from varied backgrounds and demographics.



We realize teaching and behavior modeling for just a few hours isn't all we can do. We hope to enhance our current curriculum, in collaboration with other organizations, to include training components for parents and teachers.

Fall 2019

Pilot program with full 7th grade class

In the fall/spring, 60 7th grade students in Baltimore City School, City Spring will begin work with the Restorative Justice curriculum during their first class of the day. Over the course of six classes, University of Maryland Law students and program staff will guide students through discussions of emotional responses to different scenarios with foundations in helping identify and resolve behaviors common with sexual assault predictors. The Initiative will measure the effectiveness of our sexual assault prevention curriculum in partnership with a public health consultant.


2018: A Year in Review

"That's so Erin"—it's something my aunt Wende Levitas and I find ourselves saying. Other times we talk about feeling like Erin should be somewhere with us, like she's away at school or off studying. It always catches me a bit off guard to remember that my cousin, Erin, is no longer with us.

Through the Erin Levitas Foundation, though, she is. Each of you has been a part of keeping her passion, spirit, and impact alive. The work we do every day to lift Erin's legacy, to help prevent sexual assault, is only possible because of you.

When I think about what drives this foundation, it's the same thing that drove Erin. Erin, my cousin, sick with cancer, didn't stay up at night worrying about her future. It was her experience of being raped that haunted and ultimately drove her. Erin planned to go to law school at the University of Maryland, with an eventual goal of helping defend and speak up for other victims of sexual assault.

And in November 2018, when I looked around the room during our 'Friends of the Erin Levitas Foundation' event in Baltimore, I truly understood that the issue was bigger than Erin's trauma alone.



People came up to me, telling me how important our work was for the future. They wore donor stickers with pride. They shared personal stories of sexual assault and trauma. And they wrapped each other with warmth and support.

I'm truly honored to get to work with each person who is part of our community. Our goal is clear: reduce the pain of survivors and invest in creating an empathetic communal future for our children.

In just one year, the work accomplished has been astounding. I am so appreciative for the generosity we have received, and for the efforts our talented professionals have put into this work. Together we are educating, healing, and changing the world.

Thank you. I am so proud of this community. I know Erin would be too.
